SCHEDULING ORDER

Upon due consideration of the parties' joint motion, it is hereby ordered that:

1. Defendants shall file a certified list of the contents of the Administrative Record with the Court on or before April 1, 2020, and must transmit by electronic or hard copy a complete copy of the Administrative Record to PayPal by the same date.
2. Defendants shall answer or otherwise respond to Plaintiff's complaint on or before April 13, 2020.
3. PayPal shall file any motion for summary judgment on or before May 6, 2020.
That filing shall not exceed 45 pages.

4. Defendants shall file any cross-motion for summary judgment, together with any opposition to PayPal's motion for summary judgment, on or before July 7, 2020. That filing shall not exceed 60 pages.
5. PayPal shall file any combined reply in support of its motion for summary judgment and opposition to Defendants' motion for summary judgment on or before August 21, 2020. That filing shall not exceed 45 pages.
6. Defendants shall file any reply in support of their motion for summary judgment on or before September 25, 2020. That filing shall not exceed 30 pages.
